



## Presentation Types

### Oral 20 minute concurrent podium presentation:

- Individual papers will consist of a 15-minute presentation plus 5 minutes for questions.

### Six-minute speed talk – concurrent presentation:

- Individual papers will consist of a 6 minute presentation with no more than 3 slides. Questions will be answered at the end of the session.

### Poster presentation:

- A visual display of a project and/or research results in a poster format. Presenting author(s) will be required to stand by their posters during listed poster presentation time(s).

The Scientific Committee encourages creativity in presentation of posters while maintaining scientific rigor:

- Maximum poster size is AO (841mm wide x 1189mm high). Posters will be displayed on a free standing vertical board.
- Posters are to include:
  - Title of poster
  - Name and organisation of all contributing authors (titles are not required)
  - Introduction, methods, results, conclusion, implications for practice, funding acknowledgement.
  - Text should be kept to a minimum.
  - Be creative in the graphical and pictorial representation of your research.
  - Poster displays will be available throughout the conference.



- At least one author is to be present at their poster display during session breaks in order to discuss their findings with delegates and answer questions. This provides valuable feedback for the authors about their work.
- Authors are encouraged to be creative within the space allocation for poster presentations e.g.: Short PowerPoint presentations on laptop (please provide your own laptop); Short practical demonstrations (please provide your own materials); Photographic displays; Hard copy material (paper-based/DVD/CD) for delegates can enhance dissemination of your work (please provide your own materials);
- The posting and dismantling of the posters are the responsibility of the author(s) and no responsibility will be accepted by the Conference organisers or Conference Managers for their collection or safe-keeping.
- Dismantling: All posters should remain in place for the duration of the Conference where possible. Posters are to be dismantled on 12 September, 2016 by 3:00pm.
